A mighty fortress is our God - The LORD [is] my rock, and my **fortress**, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, [and] my high tower. Ps 18:2

Our helper He, - So that we may boldly say, The Lord [is] **my helper**, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me. Heb 13:6

amid the flood of mortal ills prevailing: - Yet man is **born unto trouble**, as the sparks fly upward. Job 5:7 And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall **not prevail** against it. Matt 16:18

On earth is not his equal. - Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, **durst not** bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee. Jude 1:9

Did we in our own strength confide, - Some **[trust]** in chariots, and some in horses: but we will remember the name of the LORD our God. Ps 20:7; I am the vine, ye [are] the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye **can do nothing**. John 15:5

our striving would be losing; - For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of [them] whose heart [is] perfect* toward him. Herein thou hast done foolishly: therefore from henceforth thou shalt have wars. 2 Chr 16:9 ***reliant**

Were not the right Man on our side, - If [it had not been] the LORD who was **on our side**, when men rose up against us: Ps 124:2

the Man of God's own choosing: - While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, This is **my beloved Son**, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him. Matt 17:5; I am one that bear witness of myself, and the Father that sent me beareth witness of me. John 8:18

Dost ask who that may be? Christ Jesus, it is He; - Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a **name which is above every name**: Phil 2:9

Lord Sabaoth, His Name, - **The LORD of hosts** [is] with us; the God of Jacob [is] our refuge. Selah. Ps 46:11; Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, **I am**. John 8:58

from age to age the same, - Jesus Christ **the same** yesterday, and to day, and for ever. Heb 13:8

And He must win the battle. - But thanks [be] to God, which giveth us **the victory** through our Lord Jesus Christ. 1 Cor 15:57

And though this world, with devils filled, - [And] we know that we are of God, and **the whole world** lieth in wickedness. 1 John 5:19; Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to **seducing spirits**, and doctrines of devils; 1 Tim 4:1

should threaten to undo us, - Ye are of God, little children, and have **overcome** them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world. 1 John 4:4; Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, **shall be able to separate us** from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. Rom 8:39

We will not fear, - Therefore **will not we fear**, though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea; Ps 46:2

for God hath willed His truth to triumph through us: - Now thanks [be] unto God, which always causeth us to **triumph** in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place. 2 Cor 2:14

The Prince of Darkness grim, - Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to **the prince** of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience: Eph 2:2; For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high [places]. Eph 6:12

we tremble not for him; - **Tremble**, thou earth, at the presence of the Lord, at the presence of the God of Jacob; Ps 114:7; Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; And deliver them who through **fear of death** were all their lifetime subject to bondage. Heb 2:14 & 15

His rage we can endure, - Thou therefore **endure** hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. 2 Tim 2:3

for lo, his doom is sure, - And the devil that deceived them was **cast into the lake of fire** and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet [are], and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever. Rev 20:10

One little word shall fell him. - That at the **name of Jesus** every knee should bow, of [things] in heaven, and [things] in earth, and [things] under the earth; Phil 2:10

That word above all earthly powers, - He that cometh from above is above all: he that is of the earth is earthly, and speaketh of the earth: he that cometh from heaven is **above all**. John 3:31

no thanks to them, abideth; - To the only wise God our Saviour, [be] glory and majesty, dominion and power, both **now and ever**. Amen. Jude 1:25

The Spirit and the gifts are ours through Him Who with us sideth: - What shall we then say to these things? If God **[be] for us**, who [can be] against us? Romans 8:31

Let goods and kindred go, this mortal life also; - Lay not up for yourselves **treasures upon earth**, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: Matt 6:19/O **death**, where [is] thy sting? O grave, where [is] thy victory? 1 Cor 15:55
