

"HE SAW AND BELIEVED "

John 20:6-9: "Then Simon Peter came, following him, and went into the Tomb; and he SAW the LINEN CLOTHS lying there and the handkerchief that had been around His head, not lying with the linen cloths, but folded together in a place by itself. Then the other disciple (John), who came to the Tomb first, went in also; and he SAW and BELIEVED. For as yet they did not know the Scripture, that He must rise again from the dead."

The Tomb was not empty. The grave-clothes were still there in their position as a witness that the Lord Jesus Christ had risen from the dead. He'd passed through the grave-clothes leaving them behind in sort of a cocoon shape.
